of the President of the United States.

sixty three Stand of Arms to complete the arming of his Company of Volunteers under the Requisition
of the President of the United States.

Monday August the 17 1807

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honourable Beverly Chesden
Lewis Duvall and James Nabb.

Ordered that the Armourer at Frederick Town deliver to Colonel John Tucker on order
three hundred and thirty Stand of Arms complete.

Tuesday August the 18 1807

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honourable Beverly Chesden
Thomas W. Hall Lewis Duvall and James Nabb.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the Honourable Thomas W. Hall
the sum of fifty pounds for one quarter Salary as a Member of the Council due first Instant.

Wednesday August the 19 1807

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honourable Beverly Chesden Thomas
W. Hall and James Nabb.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Colonel John Tucker out of the
Contingent Fund one hundred and fifty Dollars as a compensation, for his attention to and care of
the Public Arms committed to his charge at different periods

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Joseph Dawson ten Dollars for
one quarter half pay due the first Instant.
