Ordered that Captain Benjamin Sprigg be authorized and requested to take all steps which may be necessary, for recovering and collecting the public Arms and Accoutrements that have been, at any time delivered to Colonel William D. Beall, Captain William Cary and Captain James Hoban as the property of the State of Maryland, and pass a receipt for the same which shall be sufficient to exonerate those, who may be now chargeable therewith, and the said Captain Sprigg is authorized to retain as many of the said Arms when collected, as are necessary to arm his select Company, and transport the residue to the City of Annapolis.

Ordered that the Armourer at Frederick Town deliver to Captain Aquila Miles or order twenty two stand of Arms for the use of his Volunteer Company.
