Monday August the 31. 1807

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honourable Revdly Clergyman,  
Thomas W. Hall, Lewis Duwall and James Nabb.

Ordered that the Armour at Frederick Town deliver to Colonel Joseph Bray a order  
four hundred Stand of Arms complete.

Ordered that the said Armour deliver to Captain Jacob Grafflin thirteen Stand of  
Arms complete.

Ordered that the said Armour deliver to Captain John M'Clure forty Stand of  
Arms complete.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Brewer Esqur. five pounds  
five Shillings and four pence half penny, it being the amount of expence incurred in bringing  
the French Prisoners to Annapolis.

Tuesday September the 1. 1807

pounds eighteen Shillings and nine pence for riding Expence to the Mayor of Baltimore,  
as per account passed by the Auditor.
