

Security to keep the peace with all persons generally and in particular with William F. Lewis until the meeting of the said Court at April Term eighteen hundred and three which was declared to be forfeited at September Term eighteen hundred and three in account of the non attendance of the said Coates that subsequent to the taking of the said Oath a perfect reconciliation took place between the said Coates and Lewis, and that Coates being an indigent Man supposed that it was not incumbent on him to appear at Court or put himself to any further trouble on the occasion. The Board on consideration of the circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the said forfeiture of fifty pounds.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain John Coates forty Dollars for six Months salary as Armorer at Eastern due the first day of May last.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the Honourable James Nabb the sum of fifty pounds for one quarter salary as a Member of the Council due the first day of August last.
