Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. John Holliday the sum of fifteen pounds for four days use of Schooner Emily and Jane in search of Venatus and taking Passengers and Guard to Baltimore, and Guards back to Annapolis.

By the Petition of William G. Thomas of Anne Arundel County it appears that he has been fined by Anne Arundel County Court six pounds for selling spirituous liquor without licence. The Petitioner states that he is a cripple, unable to maintain himself by labour, is very necessitous and poor and is unable to pay the said fine. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the said fine.

By the Petition of Timothy Lyddan of Montgomery County it appears that he was fined by Montgomery County Court in four Presentments, for Assault and Battery, the sum of thirty two Dollars being eight Dollars in each case, at March Term eighteen hundred and six. The Petitioner states that the unfortunate dispute for which he was punished, arose from the sudden impulse of the moment, with great violence, but from amiable and interesting feelings, the defence of a Father aged seventy three years who was inhumanly knocked down by the person who presented the Petitioner. That he is a peaceable and industrious Man, keeping wholly out of all Broils, never having before been sued or punished in his life time. That he is poor and has a Wife and six Children who will be reduced to great distress if the fine is exacted from him. The Board on consideration of the circumstances and from the recommendation of a number of persons of Montgomery County do remit the said fine amounting to thirty two Dollars.
