Ordered that Major Jacob Small be requested to have the arms remaining in his possession unfit for service packed up in a wooden Box and sent by the first convenient opportunity to the Armourer at Frederick Town to be repaired.

Monday October the 12 1807

The Council met. Present His Excellency The Governor and The Honourable Thomas W. Hall Lewis Duwall and James Butcher.

By the Petition of Richard Goodwin of Anne Arundel County it appears that he entered into a Recognizance for the appearance of a certain Robert Henwood at Anne Arundel County Court. The Petitioner states that being unacquainted with the particular time in which the said Henwood should have been brought into Court is the only reason why the said Recognizance was forfeited. The Petitioner states that he is a poor Man with a large family dependant on his exertions for their maintenance and support. He therefore prays to be released from the said forfeited Recognizance. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do release the said Goodwin from the said forfeiture.
