Thursday October 22. 1807

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honourable Reverdy G. Chesden.
Thomas W. Hall and Lewis Duvall.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Jabb Fowler two hundred Dollars to purchase Wood for the use of the General Assembly.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. William W. Hadaway three Dollars as per account paid.

Frisby Tilghman Esquire was appointed a Justice of the Orphans Court for Washington County vice Ignatius Taylor deceased and Commission issued to Elie Williams, Jacob Schnebly and Frisby Tilghman as Justices of the Orphans Court for said County.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Friedrich Green Esquire the sum of eighteen pounds seven shillings and six pence, as per account paid by the Auditor.

By the Petition of John H. Puffer accompanied by a Transcript from the Proceedings of the Court of Oyer and Terminer and General Jail delivery for Baltimore County it appears that he entered into a Recognizance in the sum of twenty pounds Current Money for his appearance at the said Court at July Term last to testify against a certain William F. Reed for an Assault and Battery committed on the body of the Petitioner. The Petitioner states that somewhat time before the Session of the said Court business called him to Philadelphia for which place he set out with the determination of returning in time to appear at said Court but unfortunately was arrested in Philadelphia for an unjust claim and was there detained until a few days since. That as soon as he was released he returned to Baltimore for the purpose of appearing agreeably to the tenor of his obligation when he was arrested and is now detained in prison on an Execution issued on the said forfeited Recognizance. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the said forfeiture of twenty pounds.
