

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain Perry Benson the sum of twenty two pounds ten Shillings for one quarter half pay due the first Instant.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Lieutenant John Lyon the sum of fifteen pounds for one quarter half pay due as above.

By the Petition of Edmond Lynch of Lunenburg County it appears that he was fined by the Court of the said County at May Term last the sum of one thousand pounds of Tobacco for selling spirituous Liquor without licence. The Petitioner states that he removed on the first day of January in the year eighteen hundred and six from Cecil County to Church Hill in Lunenburg County for the purpose of keeping a public Inn where one had been kept before for a number of years and considered absolutely necessary for the convenience of the public at large and more especially for Travellers who are passing and repassing every day from a great distance. That he made application to a Justice of Lunenburg County Court to grant him a permit to keep an Inn immediately on his removing to Church Hill, but the Justice considered his power had ceased as a Justice of the said Court and refused to grant the permit applied for at the time of his applying the Judiciary System in the State had been repealed and there was no person authorized by Law in the said County to grant a Permit to keep an Inn. That he in consequence of Travellers frequently calling at his House and complaining of the great inconvenience that they were subjected to from not being accommodated with necessary drink did reluctantly sell a small quantity of Liquor for which he was prevented by the Grand Jury of the said County from the information given by one of the Grand Jurors, who was present at the time the liquor was sold, and who has repeatedly declared that he would not have given such information had he not considered the oath he was then acting under compelled him to do it. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the said fine of one thousand pounds of Tobacco.
