Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Messieurs William and Washington Tuck seventeen hundred Dollars in part payment of their account against the State of Maryland for repairs to the House of Delegates Room.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Messieurs Lusby and Davis the sum of twenty one pounds one shilling and five pence it being the balance of their account the State for Repairs to the Senate Chamber.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mrs Ann LeVacher the sum of fifteen pounds for one quarters half pay due the first day of November last.
