John Darnall was appointed a Coroner for Prince Georges County and Commission issued to him accordingly.

By the Petition of Daniel Burch of Worcester County accompanied by a Transcript from the Proceedings of the Court of the said County it appears that he was by the said Court at November Term eighteen hundred and six fined the sum of six pounds Current Money for retailing Spirituous liquors without licence. The Petitioner states that he resides at an Island situated directly at Syna present Inlet at a very considerable distance from any other house. That all the Shallops and other Vessels trading from Worcester County to Philadelphia, New York and New England, as well as all others that sail from that Inlet lie at anchor near his House and take in most of their cargo. That in consequence of his situation, and before he deemed it necessary to take out licence for keeping an ordinary, he was induced by those sea faring persons in some few instances to retail Spirituous liquors. The Petitioner further states that he is in very indigent circumstances, and has a family of ten children who depend entirely upon his exertions for their support. That he has taken out a licence to keep an ordinary. He therefore prays to be released from the payment of the said sum of six pounds. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the said fine.
