Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Brewer Esquire twenty eight pounds two shillings and six pence for one quarter salary as Clerk of the House of Delegates due the first Instant.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Miriam Pinckney the sum of seventy five pounds for one quarter salary as Clerk of the Council due as above.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to the honourable Thomas. W. Hall the sum of fifty pounds for one quarter salary as a Member of the Council due as above.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to the honourable James Stabb the sum of fifty pounds for one quarter salary as a Member of the Council due as above.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to the honourable James Butcher the sum of fifty pounds for one quarter salary as a Member of the Council due as above.

Ordered by the Governor that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mrs. Rebecca Faust Ninety Dollars for one quarter half pay due as above.

Ordered by the Governor that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Lieutenant John Trueman fifteen pounds for one quarter half pay due as above.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Rogers Esquire the sum of fourteen pounds one shilling and three pence for one quarter salary as Clerk of the Senate due as above.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Mr. Subb Fowler the sum of twenty two pounds one shilling and three pence for one quarter salary as Messenger of the Council and Keeper of the State House due as above.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Lieutenant Lyon fifteen pounds for one quarter half pay due as above.
