

Tuesday February 5 1768.

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The honourable Lewis Duval
Thomas W. Hall and Reverdy G. Lincoln.

Ordered that the Treasurers of the Western Shore pay to Mr. John Shaw four hundred Dollars
in part payment of his Account for fitting up and repairing the Room in which the Court of
Appeals now hold their Session.

On the application of John Williams Esquire of Worcester County for a pre sumer in the
purchase of the State Right to all that Tract or Parcel of Land called Lumbuck's Old Field late
the property of Ephraim Tilghman which is said to be liable to Confiscation situate and lying
in Worcester County containing one hundred and fifty Acres of Land more or less excepting thereon
fifty six Acres sold by the Agent of the State to Peter Chaille and for the purchase Money of
which the said Peter Chaille gave his Bond to the State on the thirty first day of October
in the Year seventeen hundred and ninety six. The Board agreed to sell the State's right to
said Land as before excepted for the sum of Ninety seven Dollars. N. B. The Money was
paid and a Deed executed by the Chancellor accordingly.

Ordered that Captain Levy Phelps of Montgomery County be authorized and
he is hereby requested to collect the seventy two Stand of Arms complete that were
forwarded to the care of Colonel Thomas B. Beall for the use of the Select Company
raised October the first 1757 in virtue of an order of Council
collected he retain the same for the use of his Volunteer Company attached to said Regiment.

Ordered that the Treasurers of the Western Shore pay to the honourable Reverdy G. Lincoln
the sum of fifty pounds for one quarter salary as a Member of the Council due the first
Instant.

Ordered that the Treasurers of the Western Shore pay to the honourable Lewis Duval
the sum of fifty pounds for one quarter salary as a Member of the Council due as above.

Ordered that the Treasurers of the Western Shore pay to Mrs Ann LeVacher the
sum of fifteen pounds for one quarter half pay due as above.
