By the Petition of John Stichey of the City of Baltimore it appears that he was indicted at Baltimore County Court of Oyer and Terminer and Gaol Delivery at January Term last for an assault and Battery on Robert Henderson and was by the said Court at the said Term fined one hundred Dollars. The Petitioner solemnly protests that the assault did not commence with him that he has a Wife and two small Children who are dependant on his industry for support that he is in involent circumstances from various losses in trade. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of a number of respectable persons inhabitants of the said County do remit the said fine of one hundred Dollars on the said John Stichey paying the costs of prosecution.
