Ordered that Captain John Muir be requested to have Carriages made for the two Brass Pieces in the service of his Company, and that he be authorised to have one thousand Weight of suitable Balls cast for said two Guns and the three Pound Cannon used by his Company, and that the Account for the same be presented to this Board.

By the Petition of John Ashmead of Harford County it appears that he was presented in Harford County Court for selling Spirituous liquors on the Sabbath day and entered into a Recognizance in the sum of twenty pounds to attend the Court which was forfeited at August Term eighteen hundred and seven and that he is now confined upon a Capias ad satisfaciendum issued upon the said forfeiture. that he has attended the Court and submitted to the accusation and been fined for the offence. That the Cost of the Execution for the amount of the Recognizance together with the fine and Cost thereon are severely felt by him who is a very poor man and will not be able to pay the penalty of the Recognizance which he has incurred from ignorance and for which he must be sold unless it is remitted to him. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the said forfeited Recognizance of twenty pounds.
