that he was presented in two Cases for selling Spirituous liquor without licence
and fined in each Case six pounds Current Money at April Term instant.
The Petitioner states that he is a poor Man with a Wife and Children to
support. that with a view of making something for their benefit and unconscious
that he was acting against the laws of his Country did carry some Spirituous
liquor to the Field where the Militia were mustering and sold the same by
retail. The Petitioner states that unless the fines are remitted they will bring
ruin upon himself and family. The Board on consideration of which circum-
stances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do
remit the said fines.

at October Term eighteen hundred and seven for keeping a Gaming Table with a

the year eighteen hundred and seven and that at March Court eighteen hundred
and eight he appeared and submitted himself to the grace of the Court and was
fined the sum of two hundred Dollars. The Petitioner states that he was igno-
rant of the laws of the State or he would not have violated them. that he is a very
poor Man with a young growing family to provide for by his labour and that he is
entirely unable to pay the fine. The Board on consideration of which circumstances
and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the said
fine of two hundred Dollars.
