

Thursday April the 28. 1808

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honourable Lewis Duwall, Thomas W. Hall and Reverdy G. Chiselin.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. William Brewer seventy two Dollars as per Account passed by the Auditor General.

By the Petition of Samuel Grace of the City of the City of Baltimore accompanied by a Transcript from the Proceedings of the Court of Oyer and Terminer and Gaol Delivery for Baltimore County it appears that he entered into a Recognizance in the sum of ten pounds conditioned for the appearance of a certain Benjamin Taylor at the said Court on the third Monday in September last to answer for an assault alleged to have been committed by the said Taylor on the body of Joseph Manham. The Petitioner states that the said Manham on the eighth day of August last sailed from the Port of Baltimore on Board of the Schooner David commanded by Captain Wheeler bound to La Vera Cruz which Vessel has never returned but was lost with the whole of her crew. The Petitioner further states that ignorant of the necessary formalities of the law, he failed to render the said Benjamin Taylor at Court at the time above stated, as he knew of the absence of the Prosecutor, he did not suppose it necessary. The Board on consideration of the circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County to remit the said forfeiture of ten Pounds.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Miriam Pinberry seventy five pounds for one quarters salary as Clerk of the Council due as above
