By the Petition of Daniel Brustling of Cecil County it appears that he was fined by the Court of the said County at April Term Ultimo twelve pounds for keeping a disorderly House and selling liquors without license. The Petitioner states that being unable to pay the same he was ordered by the said Court to be committed to the Jail of the said County where he now lies. That he is an invalid aged sixty seven years without Money or Friends. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the said fine of twelve pounds.
