Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Messieurs Miller and Frailey the sum of thirty Dollars as per account passed by the Auditor.

By the Petition of John Watson of Queen Annes County it appears that he stands fined on the Records and Proceedings of Queen Annes County Court for the altering of a Road without having first obtained the licence of the proper authority for so doing. The Petitioner further states that the said alteration was acknowledged to be a proper one, inasmuch as the Levy Court have received the same as a part of the Public Roads for the said County, and that it is now used as such. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the said fine.

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honourable James Butcher Lewis Duwall and Reverdy G. Chislin

Ordered that the seventy Rifles contracted for by Captain Nathaniel Hyson for the use of his Company, be received and paid for by the Executive as the property of the State, provided that he give Bond and Security for their safe keeping and return when called for and have Maryland stamped on them.

Ordered that the Honourable Lewis Duwall be and he is hereby authorized to purchase three thousand Muskets of the United States, on account of the State of Maryland and agreeably to the Act of Assembly for that purpose provided, and the number of fifteen six Pounders of Mr. Frazer agreeable to the Resolution in that case provided.
