Timmonds to answer to the said Indictment and that he the Petitioner has pursued him as far
as Fort M^cIntosh for that purpose, and has expended a considerable sum as well as loss of time in
indeavouring to procure his said attendance. the Petitioner further states that he is poor and
has no means of support but from his own labour. The Board on consideration of which
circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the said
forfeiture of forty Dollars.

By the Petition of Josiah W. Heath of Somerset County accompanied by a Transcript from
the Proceedings of the Court of the said County it appears, that he was presented in three instances
at April Term last for taking illegal fees in discharging Prisoners from the Jail of the County.
The Petitioner states that he resides at the distance of ten Miles from the Seat of Justice and was
obliged to go that distance to discharge the duties claimed of him. that it has been the practice
of the Justices of the Peace of his County to charge the sum of two Dollars for the like service and
that he only charged one Dollar for the same, which was not equal to his expences, while
attending to the duties aforesaid. that he was altogether ignorant of any violation of the law.
The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court
of the said County do remit the three fines of one hundred Dollars each.

Ordered that the Secretary write to Messieurs Kemp and Crook to know if they valued
the work in the House of Delegates Room at the Baltimore rates.

Ordered that the Keeper of the Magazine at Baltimore deliver to Captain Barber
one hundred pounds of Cannon and fifty pounds of Musket Powder.

Ordered that the Companies commanded by Captain Harlin, Captain Claypoole,
Captain Thomas and Captain Paria have each one of the six Ponder. out of the seven new
Guns.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Abraham Gambell six poun
fifteen shilling for nine Months half pay due the first day of May last.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the Hon. Mr. Lincoln
sixty two Dollars and sixty one Cents as per account passed by the Council.
