The Petitioner states that immediately on the receipt of the Challenge by Gaither information was given to a Justice of the Peace who immediately recognized them both to appear at the next Court. That in consequence of an explanation which took place the misunderstanding was adjusted, and harmony restored, and the Recognizance was given up and destroyed by the Magistrate. The Petitioner states that the payment of the said fine will be attended with great inconvenience to him. The Board on consideration of the circumstances and from the recommendation of a great number of respectable persons inhabitants of Anne Arundel County do remit thirty one pounds five shillings of the said fine.
