Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the Honourable Thomas W. Hall fifty pounds for one quarter salary as a Member of the Council due this day.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Newman Pembrey seventy five pounds for one quarter salary as Clerk of the Council due this day.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Roger Esquire fourteen pounds one shilling and three pence for one quarter salary as Clerk of the Senate due this day.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Lieutenant John Freeman the sum of fifteen pounds for one quarter half pay due this day.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Lieutenant John Lynn the sum of fifteen pounds for one quarter half pay due as above.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Mr. Subb Fowler the sum of thirty nine pounds one shilling and three pence for one quarter salary as Messenger of the Council due as above.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to John Brewer Esquire the sum of twenty eight pounds two shillings and six pence for one quarter salary as Clerk of the House of Delegates due as above.

By the Petition of Benjamin Dofey of Calvert County it appears that he was presented at April Term seventeen hundred and ninety eight for buying half a Bushell of Corn and half a Bushell of Beans of Negro Sam the property of Joseph Harris and entered into a Recognizance at the Court of the said County at September Term eighteen hundred and two to appear at the following Term which was forfeited at September Term eighteen hundred and five. The Petitioner states that he has been always anxious for his trial but that for the want of the States witness it was put off from Term to Term until the Court last mentioned. That his absence at said Term was owing to his knowledge of the impossibility of getting the said witness to appear and to his ignorance of the Rules of Court. The Board on consideration of these circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do release the said Benjamin Dofey from the said forfeited Recognizance.
