The Council met Present the honourable Lewis Duwall, Thomas W. Hall and Reverdy G. Huselin.

Philip Hey Esquire was appointed a Justice of the Ophans Court for Saint Marys County in the room of Atherton Fenwick resigned and Commission issued accordingly to James Egerton, Thomas Barber and Philip Hey Esquires as Justices of the Ophan Court for said County.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. John Shaw the sum of six Dollars as per account papered by the Auditor.

The Council met Present The Honourable Lewis Duwall, Thomas W. Hall and Reverdy G. Huselin.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. John Shaw the sum of one hundred Dollars to purchase Iron for the Gun Carriages.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Norman Pinkney the sum of eleven pounds three shillings and one penny half penny as per account papered by the Auditor.

By the Petition of Doctor Richard Harrison of Anne Arundel County it appears that he was at the last Anne Arundel County Court fined the sum of fifty Dollars for committing an Assault and Battery on a certain Philip Hammond. The Petitioner states that the said Hammond was an associate of his Father and had been accustomed to be particularly and most provokingly insolent to him and that the Assault for which he was fined was so extremely trivial that the said Hammond was never for one moment laid up or sustained any material injury from the same. The Petitioner states that if he is compelled to pay the said fine that it will tend very much to embarrass his circumstances and that the said Hammond has commenced a civil Suit against him. The Board on consideration of the circumstances and from the recommendation of a number of respectable persons inhabitants of Anne Arundel County do remit thirty Dollars of the said fine.
