The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the Recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the said fine of six pounds.

By the Petition of Benjamin Banks of Anne Arundel County accompanied by a Transcript from the Proceedings of the Court of the said County it appears that he was fined in three several instances the sum of six pounds Current Money in each case for selling spirituous liquor contrary to law. The Petitioner states that he is an unfortunate cripple and not able to procure his livelihood by any other means but by labour and that he will not violate the law in future. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the said three fines of six pounds Current Money each.

The Petitioner states that he has paid to the witnesses who attended on the part of the State the sum of eighteen Dollars, and that he has paid to the witnesses independent of the fine the sum of eight Dollars and ninety seven cents which he has paid from the particular situation of things he is unable to do without.
