Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the Honourable James Butcher the sum of fifty pounds for one quarters salary as a Member of the Council due as above.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Job Fowler the sum of sixty nine pounds one shilling and three pence for one quarters salary as Messenger of the Council and Keeper of the State House due as above.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain James Sommerswell the sum of sixty five pounds Current Money for six Months half pay due the first Instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Rebecca Forest the sum of fifty Dollars for one quarters half pay due the first Instant.
