Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Samuel Green Esquire the sum of three hundred and forty five Dollars and sixty three Cents for Postage on Letters for the Executive from the twentieth of October eighteen hundred and seven to the twentieth of October eighteen hundred and eight as per Account passed by the Auditor General.

Ordered that the Seventy Rifles contracted for by Captain Woodland for the use of his Company be received and paid for by the Executive as the property of the State, provided they shall on examination be approved of by Brigadier General John Stucher, and provided also that he give Bond and Security for their safe keeping and return when called for and have Maryland stamped on them.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Charles Holland the sum of two Dollars as per Account passed by the Auditor.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Mr. John Sullivan the sum of fifteen Dollars as per Account passed by the Auditor General.
