The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honorable Lewis Duvall, Thomas W. Hall, Reverdy G. Huselin and James Hall.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain Nicholas White the sum of fifty Dollars for six Months salary as Announcer at Frederick Town due the first Instant.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Captain Nicholas White the sum of eighty nine Dollars and four cents as per account passed by the Auditor.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to the honorable Reverdy G. Huselin the sum of fifty pounds for one quarter salary as a Member of the Council due the first Instant.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Captain Perry Benson the sum of twenty two pounds ten shillings for one quarter half pay due as above.

Huselin, Lewis Duvall, Thomas W. Hall and Benjamin Hodges Esquires were elected.

Hall Esquires Councilors elect, appeared in the Council Room, and were qualified as such agreeably to the Constitution and laws of this State before Richard Menckin, Esquire one of the Justices of the Peace for Anne Arundel County, by taking, repeating and subscribing the several Oaths and the declaration prescribed for that purpose, also by taking the Oath of support to the Government of the United States. Miriam Pembrey was re-appointed Clerk of the Council and qualified before Gideon White Esquire one of the Justices of the Peace for Anne Arundel County, by taking, repeating and subscribing the several Oaths and the declaration prescribed for that purpose, as also by taking the Oath of support the Constitution of the United States.
