Wednesday December the 21/1808

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honorable James Butcher, Reverdy
G. Huselin, Lewis Duvall and Thomas W. Hall.

The Council resumed the consideration of the Appointment of Justices of the Peace and other Officers
directed by the Constitution and laws to be appointed annually and not having come to a conclusion
postponed the further consideration thereof till to Morrow.

Thursday December the 22/1808

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honorable James Butcher, Reverdy
G. Huselin, Lewis Duvall and Thomas W. Hall.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Richard White the sum of eight
Dollars as per Account passed by the Auditor.

By the Petition of Richard Hall of Queen Annes County it appears that he was fined by the Court
of the said County for keeping a Ferry known by the name of Colletts Ferry without licence. The
Petitioner states that he became resident of Queen Annes County in January last and that previous
to his keeping said Ferry was informed that no licence had been taken out for several years and that
none was necessary. The Petitioner states that he has attended said Ferry with care and attention, that
from and has a large family dependent on him for support. The Board on consideration of the same
and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the said fine.
