The Council met Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honorable Reverdy G. Gwynne Lewis Duwall and Thomas W. Hall.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas Perrin Smith Esq. twenty six Dollars for printing done for the State as per account passed by the Auditor.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Silas Engles seven Dollars for printing done for the State as per account passed by the Auditor.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Richard Fenwick the sum of twenty Dollars it being his charge for taking care of and forwarding sixty seven Muskets from the District of Columbia to the City of Annapolis.

By the return of John Bryan Barney Jordan Jacob Cable Joseph S. Crane George Waterlager, Samuel Davidsen John M. Daniel and John Gedeismen of Baltimore County it appears that they were presented at the Court of Oyer and Terminer and General Gaol Delivery for Baltimore County at January Term last for a fraudulent beating and tarring and feathering Robert Beatty on the eighteenth day of October last and were each by the said Court fined the sum of fifty Dollars and sentenced to three Months imprisonment except Samuel Davidsen who was fined twenty Dollars and sentenced to be imprisoned one Month. The Board on consideration of the circumstances and from the recommendation of a number of respectable persons inhabitants of the City and County of Baltimore do remit the whole of the said fines except one Cent in each case.
