Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas Rogers Esquire the sum of fourteen pounds one shilling and three pence for one quarters Salary as Clerk of the Senate due the first day of February instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. J. B. Fowler the sum of thirty nine pounds one shilling and three pence for one quarters Salary as Messenger of the Council and Keeper of the Court House due the first Instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Lieutenant John Lynn the sum of fifteen pounds for one quarters half pay due as above.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the honorable Lewis Duwall fifty pounds for one quarters Salary as a Member of the Council due as above.
