Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Numain Pinney Seventy five
pounds for one quarters salary as Clerk of the Council due the first instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the Honorable James Butcher
the sum of fifty pounds for one quarters salary as a Member of the Council due as above

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas Rogers Esquire The
sum of fourteen pounds one shilling and three pence for one quarters salary as Clerk
of the Senate due the first day of February instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Webb Fowler The sum
of thirty nine pounds one shilling and three pence for one quarters salary as messenger of
the Council and keeper of the flat House due the first instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Lieutenant John Lynn the sum of
fifteen pounds for one quarters half pay due as above.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the Honorable Lewis Duvall fifty
pounds for one quarters salary as a Member of the Council due as above.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Brewer Esquire The sum
of twenty eight pounds two shillings and six pence for one quarters salary as Clerk of the
House of Delegates due as above.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the Honorable Thomas W. Hall
the sum of fifty pounds for one quarters salary as a Member of the Council due as above.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the Honorable Assembly of his
State the sum of fifty pounds for one quarters salary as a Member of the Council due as above.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Lieutenant John Lueman the
sum of fifteen pounds for one quarters half pay due as above.
