Ordered that the Resolution of the Legislature, passed at the last Session, requesting the Governor and Council to procure information as to the probable expenses of erecting and furnishing a building of sufficient dimensions for the manufacturing annually one thousand stand of arms complete, be published twice a week for the space of four weeks, in the American and Federal Gazette at Baltimore, the Maryland Gazette at Annapolis, the Republican Advocate at Frederick Town, the National Intelligencer, the Maryland Herald at Hagerstown and in Mr. Smith's Paper at Easton.
