The Council met pursuant to the honorable Isaac Braucher Provost of the Hon. Lewis Duane
Thomas Hall and Benjamin Haden.

His Excellency Robert Wright Esquire having resigned on Saturday the sixth
Instant the honorable Isaac Braucher qualified as Governor before Gideon White
Esquire one of the Justices of the Peace of Anne Arundel County in the Council Room
in the presence of the Members of the Council agreeably to the twenty second Section of
the Constitution and Form of Government.

Resolved that Robert Welch of New York be authorized to proceed to Philadelphia and
receive from Captain Lewis Superintendent of Military Stores for the United States the
four thousand stand of Arms purchased for the United States by this State, and cause them
to be immediately shipped to Baltimore and he is hereby requested to have the Arms
received in Baltimore for their safe transportation from Philadelphia to that Port and
draw an order on the Secretary for the amount of his disbursements.

Resolved that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. William Whittington
one dollar and twenty cents and make good a paper account passed by the Auditor.

Resolved that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the second returned Sheriff for
Charles County in the name of Joseph Lewis Esquire the sum returned.

Resolved that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. John LeDachon the sum
of fifteen pounds for one year and six pence and the first balance.

Resolved that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Betty Summerson the
sum of four pounds for one year and six pence for his private pay for taking
care of and conveying the public Store pay.
