Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr Rebecca Forest the Sum of twenty five pounds for one quarter salary as a Justice of the Peace due the first Instant.  
Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Frederick Green Esquire the Sum of three hundred Dollars for one quarter salary as a Justice of the Peace due as above.

Thomas T. Johnson appeared a Justice of the Peace for Worcester County vice William Holland dead and bonds for him joined to the said County including him.

The Court was then called to order for the second Judicial District of Maryland to supply the vacancy occasioned by the death of the honorable James Highmore the Court being directed in the said case on examination thereof to appoint the Honorable Michael H. Spenser Esquire as a Justice of the Peace whereupon it is declared in the Court that the said Michael H. Spenser Esquire is appointed Chief Justice of the second Judicial District of Maryland.
