At a meeting of the General Assembly of Maryland pursuant to a Proclamation issued by his Excellency James Butcher Esquire for the purpose of appointing a Governor for the residue of the Year in the room of Robert Wright Esquire resigned, they proceeded to the said appointment when the honorable Edward Lloyd was appointed.

Wednesday June the 7 1809

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Lazarus Hammond seven pounds Ten Shillings for six Months half pay due the first day of May last.

By the Petition of Theodore Dent and Gerard Buisco it appears that they entered into a Recognizance in the sum of twenty five pounds each for the appearance of Zachariah Clements at Charles County Court at August Term eighteen hundred and seven and good behavior to Walter Jamison. The Petitioners state that the said Zachariah Clements committed no breach of the Peace, neither on the quietty of any act the ground of a Criminal prosecution, neither did the said Jamison attend the said Court to claim a renewal of his oath, that the said Clements did not attend the said Court but removed to the City of Washington. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the whole of the said forfeitures.
