It further appears by the Certificate of Justice William Leonard that he agreed with the said C. Luborn on the twenty eighth day of March eighteen hundred and nine to let him the said Luborn have the use of his licence which he obtained at August Term eighteen hundred and eight for the purpose of keeping a Tavern at the Cross Roads on Slate ridge, which place he rented to the said Luborn on the said twenty eighth day of March. The Certificate further states that he violated the law through ignorance and not from design. The Board on consideration of a full communication and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the said fine.
