

several Cases at August Term eighteen hundred and nine the quantity of six hundred pounds of Tobacco each case for selling Spirituous liquors without licence. The Petitioner states that at the time of selling the said liquor he resided at a Ferry on the Road from Frederick Town to George Town and where the said Road crosses the River at the said Ferry that it had always been customary to sell Spirituous liquors by the small quantity and that he being an uninformed Man supposed that a licence which he had obtained from the Court of Frederick County to keep the said Ferry authorized him to retail liquors in the same manner that other occupants of the said Ferry house had done. The Petitioner declares that he had no intention what-soever of offending against the laws of the State and that he fully believed that his licence which he obtained to keep the Ferry authorized him to retail the said Spirituous liquors. that he is extremely poor and that by many misfortunes and losses he has been driven to the necessity of applying for the benefit of the Insolvent Law - that he has a large family entirely dependant on his daily labour for support. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the said fine of six hundred pounds of Tobacco.
