

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the Honorable George E. Mitchell the sum of fifty pounds for one quarters Salary as a Member of the Council due the first day of February last.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Richard B. Watts the sum of one hundred and fifty Dollars to be by him accounted for.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the Clerk of the Council the sum of five Dollars to be by him forwarded to the Editors of the Centinel and Chronicle in full for two papers to the first of March Instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Frederick Green the sum of one hundred Dollars for half years Salary as Quarten to the State due the first day of February last.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain Perry Brown the sum of one hundred pounds for the flings for one quarters half pay due the first day of February last.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the Honorable George E. Mitchell the sum of fifty pounds for one quarters Salary as a Member of the Council due the first day of February last.

Resolved that the following Act be read an Act to alter and abolish that part of the Constitution which requires the Citizens of Annapolis to vote for Delegates for Anne Arundel County, an Act to amend the same concerning the mode of taking an oath to support the same, an Act to repeal and abolish the forty fifth Article of the Constitution and Form of Government, an Act to alter the mode of the Constitution and Form of Government as relate to the election and qualification of Voters, an Act to alter such part of the Declaration of Rights, Constitution and Form of Government, as make it lawful to lay an equal and general Tax for the support of the Christian Religion and an Act to alter and abolish all such parts of the Constitution and Form of Government as require a property qualification or require to be appointed or holding offices of Justice and such other offices and in persons elected Members of the Legislature or Electors of the Senate to be published once in each week for the space of three Months successively in the City of Annapolis and Federal Gazette at Baltimore, the Maryland Republican and Maryland Gazette at Annapolis and in the Star at London.

Ordered that the sum of five hundred pounds be directed to be forwarded to Captain John C. Calve one hundred pounds field piece for the use of his Company of Artillery.
