By the Petition of William Jacobs of Baltimore County accompanied by a Transcript from
the Proceedings of the Court of Oyer and Terminer and Gaol Delivery for the said County it
appears that he was fined at January Term last in three several cases the sum of six pounds
Current Money in each case for selling spirituous liquors without licence. The Petitioner states
that he received from the Court of Oyer and Terminer of Baltimore County a licence to keep a
Tavern in said County - that about six Months since he was taken sick and continued extremely
ill until the first day of January eighteen hundred and ten and still continues to be in bad
health. that during the greater part of the time of his confinement his life was despaired of by
his Physician. that during the period of his indisposition some of his family sold liquors. The
Petitioner states that indisposition and not an intention to evade the law caused him to neglect
renewing his licence. that he is poor and has a large family to support. The Board on consid-
eration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County
do remit the said fines.

Ordered that John Smith Brooker a State Debtor be indulged until the next meet-
ing of the General Assembly agreeably to a Resolution of November Session eighteen hun-
dred and nine.

Ordered that Mr. John Shaw deliver to Captain John Meredith of Eastern county
Stand of Arms complete he having given Bond for their return in good order when called.

Ordered that the Bill entitled An Act respecting the equity jurisdiction of the County
Courts, be published once in each Week for the space of six Weeks, in the Maryland Gazette and
Maryland Republican at Annapolis and the Star at Eastern.

Ordered that Mr. John Shaw be directed to forward to Captain Samuel Thomas of
Talbot County one six pound Field Piece for the use of his Company of Artillery.

By the Petition of William Causeway of Dorchester County it appears that he is indebted
a Recognizance in the sum of twenty pounds Current Money for his appearance at the Court
