

Saturday April the 21 1810

The Honorable Reverdy G. Hise and Lewis Duval occasionally attended from this day to Saturday the fifth day of May.

Monday May the 7 1810

The Council met. Present His Excellency The Governor and The Honorable James Butcher, George F. Mitchell, Thomas W. Hall, Reverdy G. Hise and Lewis Duval.

By the Petition of Gustavus W. T. Wright it appears that he was fined by Talbot County Court at November Term eighteen hundred and nine in the two following cases to wit. Thirty Dollars for sending a Challenge to Samuel B. Beach and thirty Dollars for sending a Challenge to Vachel Keene, and that William G. Elbert and John S. Blake his Seconds were each fined thirty Dollars. The Board on consideration do remit fifty eight Dollars of the fines that were imposed on Gustavus W. T. Wright, twenty nine Dollars of the fine that was imposed on William G. Elbert and twenty nine Dollars of the fine that was imposed on John S. Blake.

Ordered that Daniel Carroll and Zachariah Maschubin be indulged until the next meeting of the General Assembly on their paying up the Interest and Costs of Suit.

By the Petition of Benjamin Williams accompanied by a Transcript from the Proceedings of Calvert County Court it appears that he entered into a Recognizance in the Sum of twenty pounds Current Money for the appearance of a certain Jesse Fowler at the said Court at May Term eighteen hundred and seven to answer a charge of taking and carrying away Bricks from the Gaol the property of Calvert County. The Petitioner states that the said Jesse Fowler did attend at May Term eighteen hundred and seven and was anxious to have his case tried, but not being in the Court House on the day of the Term when the Recognizance Docket was called over his Recognizance was forfeited. That after the expiration of the May Court and before the next the said Jesse Fowler petitioned for and did obtain a Noli Prosequi to stop the Proceedings against him in the said Court. That at the next Court which was in October eighteen hundred and seven the said Fowler did file in the said Court the said Noli Prosequi and thus put an end to all further Proceedings against him upon the said Indictment. The Petitioner states that the said Fowler is since dead and that he has been called upon by the Sheriff for the said Sum of twenty pounds. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the said forfeiture of twenty Pounds.
