On the Application of Robert Watts of Queen Annes County to purchase the following piece of land it being part of Queen Annes Manor which is said to be liable to confiscation beginning at the South East Corner of Spring Garden and running from thence with the said Land North one acre fifteen Minutes West one hundred and sixty six perches and South four degrees East one hundred and sixty six perches and from thence a straight line to the beginning containing twenty one Acres and three fourths of an acre of land more or less. The Board agreed to sell the State right to said Land for the sum of forty shillings per acre it being the amount of a valuation put on said Land by James Brown and Samuel Burges, who were appointed by the Executive on the twenty second day of July eighteen hundred and seven to value said Land.
