Robert Wright Esquire was appointed Clerk of Queen Annes County Court vice Samuel T. Wright deceased to hold the said office until the meeting of the next Court and Commission issued to him accordingly.

John Hilly Esquire was appointed Adjutant General of the State of Maryland in the room of Samuel T. Wright and Commission issued to him accordingly.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. John Munroe the sum of six hundred and forty four Dollars it being the amount of his account for making four hundred Cartouch Boxes as per account passed by the Auditor.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. James Williamson the sum of six hundred and forty four Dollars, it being the amount of his account for making four hundred Cartouch Boxes as per account passed by the Auditor.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Colonel Jacob Small the sum of eleven dollars it being the amount paid by him for freight on arms as per Receipts lodged with the Auditor General.
