

Ordered that the Clerk of the Council make application to Mr. Henry Foxall for two six pound Iron Field Pieces to be delivered at Annapolis as early as possible.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain James Bruff the sum of twenty two pounds ten shillings for one quarters half pay due the first day of May last.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Jonathan Conkney Esquire Cashier of the Farmers Bank of Maryland thirteen thousand two hundred and seventeen Dollars to be by him placed to the credit of Thomas T. Tucker Esquire Treasurer of the United States in trust for said States, and subject to the order of said Tucker, for the purchase of arms in pursuance of an act of a Assembly entitled an act to empower the Executive to purchase arms for the use of the Militia of this State and for other purposes therein mentioned, passed at November Session eighteen hundred and eight.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Jonathan Conkney Esquire Cashier of the Farmers Bank of Maryland the sum of four thousand eight hundred and sixty eight Dollars to be by him placed to the credit of Thomas T. Tucker Esquire Treasurer of the United States, in trust for said States, and subject to the order of the said Tucker, for the purchase of four hundred Cavalry Pistols and four hundred Horseman Swords in pursuance of a Resolution of the General Assembly passed at November Session eighteen hundred and eight

The Honorable Reverdy G. Huselin and Lewis Duvall occasionally attended in the Council Room from this day to Friday the twentieth Instant.

Saturday July the 21 1810

The Council met. Present The Honorable Thomas W. Hall, Reverdy G. Huselin and Lewis Duvall.

Ordered that Mr. Robert Welch of Ben be authorized to proceed to Philadelphia, and receive from Captain Irvine Superintendent of Military Stores for the United States, the twelve hundred stand of arms, two hundred and fifty pair of Horsemen Pistols and five hundred Horsemen Swords purchased from the United States by this State and cause them to be immediately transported to Annapolis.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Robert Welch of Ben the sum of one hundred Dollars towards defraying the expenses of transporting the arms from Philadelphia to Annapolis to be by him accounted for.
