

Tuesday August the 14 1810

The Council met. Present The Honorable Reverdy G. Hise and Lewis Duvall.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Richard B. Watts the sum of three hundred Dollars to be by him accounted for.

Wednesday August the 15 1810

The Honorable Reverdy G. Hise and Lewis Duvall occasionally attended in the Council Room from this day to Saturday the twenty fifth.

Monday August the 27 1810

The Council met. Present The Honorable Reverdy G. Hise and Lewis Duvall.

Thomas Hennis was appointed a Coroner of Talbot County vice Charles Hennis resigned, and Commission issued to him accordingly.

By the Petition of Samuel Hail of Allegany County it appears that October Term eighteen hundred and seven a presentment was found against him by the Grand Jury of the said County for committing an affray, and that a Writ was issued against him returnable to April Term eighteen hundred and eight upon which the Petitioner was arrested by the Sheriff of Allegany County and entered into a Bail Bond in the penal sum of one hundred pounds current Money with a condition that he should appear at the said Court at April Term eighteen hundred and eight to answer to the presentment, which said Bond was forfeited in consequence of the Petitioner not appearing at the said Term and Judgment obtained against him for the sum of one hundred pounds the penalty of the said Bond. The Petitioner states that it was his intention to have complied with the condition of the Bond and to have traversed the presentment, but there being high Water in the River Potomac a few days before the sitting of the Court when he was to have appeared and he following Boating for a livelihood he went to George Town with a Boat expecting to return before the sitting of the Court but was unable to get back in time. That he has no means of paying the said forfeiture and unless released from the payment of the same must be confined in Jail during the remainder of his life. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the said forfeiture of one hundred pounds current Money.
