The State of Maryland To the Sheriff of Frederick County Greeting. Whereas by the Resignation of the Honourable Roger Nelson Esquire a Vacancy has arisen in the Representation of this State in the House of Representatives of the United States, which Vacancy according to an Act of a Assembly passed at November Session Seventeen hundred and Ninety entitled an Act directing the time places and manner of holding Elections for Representatives of this State in the Congress of the United States, and for appointing Electors on the part of this State for choosing a President and Vice President of the United States and for the regulation of the said Elections and also to repeal the Act of a Assembly therein mentioned: and according to another Act of the General Assembly Supplementary to the Act aforesaid passed at November Session Seventeen hundred and Ninety one, must be filled by a person resident within and elected by the qualified Voters of the fourth District of this State as designated by the said Acts of a Assembly. We do therefore in pursuance of the powers vested in us by the Acts aforesaid and the Act entitled "an Act to reduce into one the several Acts of a Assembly respecting elections, and to regulate said Elections" passed at November Session eighteen hundred and five, authorize and command you to appoint a day to hold an Election in that part of Frederick County which with Washington and Allegany Counties compose the fourth District for a Representative of this State to fill the Vacancy in the House of Representatives of the United States occasioned by the resignation of the aforesaid Roger Nelson Esquire, and the said Election shall be held within fifteen days after the receipt of this Warrant, and you shall serve a Copy thereof on each of the Judges in each election District of said part of Frederick County at least three days before the day appointed for holding such Election. Given in Council at the City of Annapolis under the Seal of the State of Maryland this seventh day of September in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ten.
