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Saturday November the 10. 1810

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honourable Reverdy & his son George E. Mitchell Thomas W. Hall and Lewis Duval.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the Honourable George E. Mitchell the sum of one hundred pounds for six Months Salary as a Member of the Council due the first Instant.

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Monday November the 12. 1810

The Council met. Present The Honourable Reverdy & his son George E. Mitchell and Thomas W. Hall.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Sewell the sum of fifty one Dollars for painting done to the Door of the Armoury and for the as per account passed by the Auditor General.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr John Shaw the sum of eighty two pounds six shillings and four pence half penny as per account passed by the Auditor.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Betty Sumner out of the Contingent Fund four pounds seventeen shillings and six pence for six Months pay for cleaning the Public Necessary due the first Instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr Thomas Shaw and Co. the sum of five pounds five shillings and three pence half penny as per account passed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain Robert Denny the sum of seventy five pounds for one quarters Salary as Auditor General due the first Instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr Lazarus Hammond the sum of fifteen pounds for one years half pay due as above.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Doctor John Coates the sum of thirty pounds for one years Salary as Armourer at Easton due the first Instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Samuel Green Esquire the sum of two hundred and seven Dollars and fifty five and a half cents for Postages for the Governor as per account passed by the Auditor General.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mrs Ann Le Vacher the sum of fifteen pounds for one quarters half pay due the first Instant.
