The Council met. Present His Excellency The Governor and The Honorable John Stephen, Reverdy G. Hise and Thomas W. Hall.

Edward Scott was appointed coroner for Prince Georges County in the room of John Darnall resigned and Commission issued to him accordingly.

Charles G. Spaw was appointed one of the coroners for Montgomery County and Commission issued to him accordingly.

The Board being in possession of the Returns from the Counties of Queen Annes, Talbot and Caroline of an Election held for the choice of a Representative or Representatives of the seventh District in the Congress of the United States to supply the vacancies occasioned by the Resignation of the Honorable John Browne by which it appears that the honorable Robert Wright was elected. Therefore it is declared that the said Robert Wright is duly elected a Representative of this State in the Congress of the United States. Given in Council, at the City of Annapolis, under the Great Seal of the State of Maryland this twenty ninth day of November in the Year of our Lord one Thousand eight Hundred and ten and of the Independence of the United States of America the thirty fifth.
