Whereas a certain David Johnston otherwise called David Stockney alias David Nash is charged by the affidavit of Jeremiah Summers of the County of Gloucester and State of New Jersey, Marmer, with the crime of stealing from on board of the Schooner Independence then lying in the Port of Philadelphia in the State of Pennsylvania six hundred Dollars or thereabouts in specie the Money Goods and Chattels of the said Jeremiah Summers, an authentic copy of which affidavit has been transmitted to us by his Excellency the Governor of Pennsylvania. And Whereas it is represented to us by His Excellency Simon Snyder Governor of the said State of Pennsylvania that the said David Johnston otherwise called David Stockney alias David Nash has fled from the said State from Justice and is now confined in the Jail of Baltimore County in this State. and the said Simon Snyder, Esquire, hath in pursuance of the Constitution of the United States and the Act of Congress entitled "an Act respecting fugitives from Justice and persons escaping from the service of their Masters" demanded of us that the said David Johnston alias David Stockney alias David Nash be delivered up to William Fry of the City of Baltimore, to be removed to the said State of Pennsylvania having jurisdiction of the crime wherewith he is charged. You are therefore hereby commanded to deliver the said David Johnston alias David Stockney alias David Nash to the said William Fry to be removed to the said State provided he does not stand charged with any offence against the laws of this State and how you shall execute this Warrant you shall notify to us with all convenient dispatch. Given in Council at the City of Annapolis under the Great Seal of the State of Maryland this twenty sixth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ten.
