Ordered that upon the completion of the printing of the Laws passed at November Session eighteen hundred and ten, and the fulfillment of all the official duties incumbent upon Frederick Green late Printer to the State, by his legal Representative, the balance of the Salary allowed said Printer by Law shall be paid to said Representative at such time and in such manner, as the same would have been paid to the said deceased, in case the duties above mentioned had been performed by him.
