

Samuel Smith, John E. Howard, Joseph H. Nicholson, Alexander M. Moore, Tobias E. Stansbury, William Hawkins, George Warner, Samuel Glenn, Theodorick Bland and David Fulton, Esquires, were appointed Inspectors of the Penitentiary House for Baltimore County, to hold the appointment during the term limited by the act of Assembly, entitled "An act concerning Cumes and Punishments" passed at November Session eighteen hundred and nine.

The Board proceeded to elect an attorney General of the State of Maryland to supply the vacancy occasioned by the resignation of the Honorable John Johnson. The Ballot being deposited in the Ballot Box on examination thereof it appeared that the Honorable James Houston was appointed. Whereupon it is declared in the Council that the said James Houston is duly elected attorney General of Maryland. Ordered that Commission issue. Commission issued to him accordingly.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the Clerk of the Council the sum of fifteen Dollars it being the amount paid by him for subscription to the Whig as per receipt filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain James Bruff the sum of twenty two pounds ten Shillings for one quarter half pay due the first day of February last.

Doctor James Thomas was appointed a Justice of the Orphans Court for Saint Marys County in the room of Doctor Henry Ashton resigned and Commission issued to Thomas Barber, Philip Key and Doctor James Thomas as Justices of the Orphans Court for said County.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. John White the sum of fifteen Dollars as per account passed by the Auditor General.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. John Hicks the sum of thirty seven Dollars and fifty cents on account of Board for Indians as per account passed by the Auditor General.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Messieurs Irvine and Barnes the sum of forty five Dollars and seventy five cents as per account passed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain Nicholas White the sum of fifty Dollars for two quarters salary as Armourer at Frederick Town due the first day of November last.

Mr. Washington G. Tuck was appointed Armourer at Annapolis. Ordered that he be notified of the same by the Clerk. Notified accordingly.

By the Petition of James Morgan of Caroline County it appears that through error in taking a Permit from one of the Justices of the Orphans Court at Annapolis
