By the Petition of John M'Williams late Sheriff of Saint Mary's County it appears that a Presentment was found in Saint Mary's County Court at March Term eighteen hundred and eleven against a certain Kenebm Gray for stealing five hundred weight of Tadder the property of the Heirs of William Thompson. that a Writ was directed to the Petitioner as Sheriff of the said County and was served on the said Gray who a little before the ensuing thereafter a Guard was and has never since been seen in this State. The Petitioner states that in consequence thereof he was finally amerced by the said Court in the Sum of twenty pounds at March Term eighteen hundred and eleven. The Petitioner states that he was induced from the opinion which the Neighbourhood entertained of said Gray's innocence. from his poverty and the busy season of the Year being Harvest and no person to aid him but his Wife to suffer him to go at large without Bail. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the said Amercement of twenty Pounds.
